- 1. **The Hebrew # 12** stands for authority of God's kingdom.
- 2. **12 Tribes of Israel.** 12 apostles, 12 minor prophets, Jesus spoke at the temple 12 times, 12 months in a year, & 12 gates in the New Jerusalem. The 12 stones memorials at the Red Sea & Jordan. The Tree of life will bear 12 fruits.

Joshua 4:1-6

Markers of God's P.P.P.P.

- 1. V:1 The Stones: They came from the middle of the Jordan. Representing God's Presence was with the whole Nation.
- 2. **V:2-3 The Stones:** They came from where the priests were standing. This is the symbol of God's Power to hold back the water.
- 3. **V:4-6** The Stones: Were to be stacked at the place where they laid their heads on their first night in the promise land.
 - A. God's Provision a place of rest.
 - B. God's Promises are faithful commitments to the His followers.

Joshua 7:7-10

Spiritual Reminders

- 1. **Joshua 3:15** Now the Jordan was at flood stage. Could be from ½ mile wide or longer.
- 2. **Joshua 4:9** Joshua sets up 12 stones in the middle of the river where the priest stood with the ARK.
- 3. **The hidden 12 stones**: The only time people would see them was during a draught.

- 4. **V:10 Just as Moses** had directed. Moses built the stones of remembrance as they crossed the Red Sea. One symbol of remembrance points to another.
- 5. **Multi-generational reminders** keep the anchor secure just a little longer. Don't be the generation that quits pointing to God.

Joshua 4:10c-18

Ready for the Next Step

- 1. **V:12-13 Forty thousand** fighting men went before them as mighty army for the people to follow. (These tribes would live east of the Jordan.)
- 2. V:15-18 The Lord directed when to go, when to stand, and when to come out of the Jordan. Then it returned to flood stage.
- 3. **God went before** them. God's presence stood in the middle of uncertainty. God had their back as they crossed. How many where lost in this flood stage crossing. Zero.

Joshua 4:19-24

"The Future Generations Must Know"

- 1. **V:19** The story behind the story. The 10th day of Nisan in this story is the preparation time for the 40th anniversary of Passover.
- 2. There is a woman waiting (Rahab) for this gift of Passover in Jericho with a scarlet thread marking her faith.
- 3. Was the ground really dry? How? Exodus 14:21-22
- 4. **V:24** God did this so the people of the earth might know the hand, the power, and fear the Lord your God.
