Acts 7:39-44

Turning Back To...

- 1. V:39 Egypt: represents a people who are willing to turn back to captivity to have normal life again.
- 2. V:40-41 Idols: Come into play when you don't gather to worship the living God, you will turn back to false worship.
- 3. V:43-44 Tabernacles: represent a meeting place. It's a turning back to gatherings without God. Their hearts abandon the genuine tabernacle that was right there in their camp.

Stiff-Necked People

- 1. They have hearts and ears that are not listening to the Holy Spirit.
- 2. **They resist** surrendering to the Holy Spirit to circumcise (Cut away the fleshly desires) their hearts and ears.

Acts 7:52-60

Hearts & Ears that Don't Work

- 1. **V:57 Their ears** are covered. They are blocked, in this case by their own hands and their yelling.
- 2. V:58 Plugged ears & hearts will become dangerous to the Christian.
- 3. Stephen didn't stop proclaiming truth, just because they refused to hear it.

In The Last Days...

- 1. We need the history of God's faithfulness, because this a source of stability.
- 2. Surrendering to the Holy Spirit is the key solution to all the distractions.
- 3. Keeping your heart tender allows your ears to hear what the Spirit is saying to the Church.
