### “When God Speaks”

1. **Genesis 6:13-14 & 8:3-4** (The 1<sup>st</sup> homestay & a possible Passover’s shadow?)

**Genesis 6:13** So God said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them and the earth. 14 **So make yourself an ark** of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out.

**Genesis 8:3** The water receded steadily from the earth. At the end of the hundred and fifty days the water had gone down, 4 and on **the seventeenth day of the seventh month the ark came to rest** on the mountains of Ararat. (Why is God so specific on the day of this occurrence?) **4,000 years in the future it is Resurrection day)**

### “When God Speaks”

2. **Exodus 12:1-16** (The 1<sup>st</sup> Passover)
3. **Exodus 19:9** (The 1<sup>st</sup> Pentecost)

**Exodus 12:1** The LORD said to Moses and Aaron in Egypt, 2 "This month is to be for you the first month, the first month of your year. 3 **Tell the whole community of Israel that on the tenth day of this month** each man is to take a lamb for his family, one for each household.

**Exodus 19:9** The LORD said to Moses, "**I am going to come to you in a dense cloud, so that the people will hear me speaking with you and will always put their trust in you.**" Then Moses told the LORD what the people had said.

## “People who Listen to God”

1. **Will experience** freedom from wrath (Noah) from bondage (Israel)
2. **Will hear** from God. (Moses)
3. **Will have boundaries** and a healthy relationship with God & others (10 Commandments)

## “When God Speaks”

4. **Joshua 3:5 – 5:10-11** (Preparation for Passover & 1<sup>st</sup> Passover in the Promised land)

**Joshua 3:5** Joshua told the people, "Consecrate yourselves, **for tomorrow the LORD will do amazing things among you.**"

**Joshua 5:10-12** On the evening of **the fourteenth day of the month**, while camped at Gilgal on the plains of Jericho, the Israelites celebrated the **Passover**. 11 The day after the Passover, **that very day, they ate some of the produce of the land:** unleavened bread and roasted grain. 12 **The manna stopped the day after** they ate this food from the land;

**Joshua 6:25** But Joshua spared Rahab the prostitute, with her family and all who belonged to her, because she hid the men Joshua had sent as spies to Jericho—and she lives among the Israelites to this day.

## When a Convergence Happens

1. A **convergence is** when a God event in the past is mirrored in the present.
2. **Joshua 3:5 – 5:10-11** Passover and Pentecost has a strange convergence.

**Matthew 1:5** Salmon the father of **Boaz, whose mother was Rahab**, Boaz the father of Obed, whose mother was Ruth, Obed the father of Jesse, [\(Wait, what? Rahab is back in the story in a significant manner.\)](#)
