

What if Amos 4:2 is a part of God's judgement on those who don't honor His warning on dividing the land found in Joel 3:2?

*Amos 4:2 The Sovereign LORD has sworn by his holiness: "The time will surely come when you will be taken away with hooks, the last of you with fishhooks.

_____ is an <u>Italian surname</u>. It is derived from the <u>Sicilian</u> word for "<u>sickle</u>" A **sickle**, **bagging hook** or **reaping-hook** is a single-handed <u>agricultural tool</u> designed with variously curved <u>blades</u> and typically used for <u>harvesting</u>, or cutting.

- *Amos 5:1 Hear this word, Israel, this lament I take up concerning you:
- *Amos 5:2 "Fallen is Virgin Israel, never to rise again, deserted in her own land, with no one to lift her up."
- *Amos 5: 3 This is what the Sovereign LORD says to Israel: "Your city that marches out a thousand strong will have only a hundred left; your town that marches out a hundred strong will have only ten left."

"God Mourns When..."

- 1. Amos 5:1 & 10 When "Truth" is rejected, loathed, disliked, or hated.
- 2. Amos 5:2 When God's people choose to be deserted, rather than to call on Him.
- 3. Amos 5:3 When we are decimated by our choices. Yet, we continue to misplace our security in past victories and situations.

"The Past is Marred by the Present" (Amos 5:5)

- **1. Bethel**, **Gilgal**, and **Beersheba** were once places associated with great privilege and spiritual heritage. Now places of *vain*, *empty worship*.
- **2. Bethel** was the place where God met Jacob (Genesis 28:11-19, Genesis 35:1-7). **Gilgal** was the place where Israel's spiritual reproach was rolled away in the days of Joshua (Joshua 5:1-12).
- **3. Beersheba** was connected to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Genesis 21:22-33, 26:23-33, 46:1-5).

- *Amos 5:10 There are those who hate the one who upholds justice in court and detest the one who tells the truth.
- *Amos 5:13 Therefore the prudent keep quiet in such times, for the times are evil.
- *Amos 5:14 Seek good, not evil, that you may live. Then the LORD God Almighty will be with you, just as you say he is.

"The Cause, the Curse & the Cure"

- 1. **Falsehood** became the norm and a total rejection of truth.
- 2. **Hatred of Government** with its corruption and unfair courts while the elite mistreat the people.
- 3. V:4, 6, &14 Seek God and live. Seek good not evil.

A Key Misunderstanding of the Future

- *Amos 5:18 Woe to you who long for the day of the LORD! Why do you long for the day of the LORD? That day will be darkness, not light.
- *Amos 5:19 It will be as though a man fled from a lion only to meet a bear, as though he entered his house and rested his hand on the wall only to have a snake bite him.
- *Amos 5:20 Will not the day of the LORD be darkness, not light—pitch-dark, without a ray of brightness?
- *Amos 5:21 "I hate, I despise your religious festivals; your assemblies are a stench to me.
 - 1. **Christian Schools** have wrongly the believed the day of Lord is what they are looking forward to as taught by Amillennialism.
 - 2. **Blindness** about the day of Lord is keeping many Christians unprepared.
 - 3. I hate, I despise your feast days: This would have amazed and offended those in Israel who heard Amos say this. They told themselves that they were really honoring God and pleasing Him by their observance of the feasts and sacred assemblies, but God was offended by their religious ceremonialism, disconnected from the heart, justice towards one another, and the Day of the Lord.
- *Amos 5:4 This is what the LORD says to Israel: "Seek me and live;
