

Acts 2:11-13

"The Power of God"

- 1. The Wonders of God lead us to Worship.
- 2. The Anti-Christ will come with wonders and signs.
- 3. The greatest wonder is a transformed life.

"Pentecost"

- 1. Nisan- holds 3 of the 7 feasts, Passover, Unleavened Bread, First Fruits.
- 2. **Tishri-** holds 3 of the 7 feasts, <u>Trumpets</u>, <u>The Day of Atonement</u>, <u>Tabernacles</u>.
- 3. **Pentecost-** is the in-between feast of the 7 feasts. They count 7 weeks plus one day after the feast of Frist Fruits. Pentecost means fifty.
- 4. All 7 Jewish feasts are both historical and prophetical.

Acts 2:14-21

When a speaker sits down, they are teaching. When a speaker stands up, they are a proclaimer, messenger, or a representative. (Note Peter quotes from Joel Chapter 3)

Prophecy

2 Peter1:19 We also have the prophetic message as something completely reliable, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.

2 Peter 1:19 (KJV)We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:
