Acts 12:1-7

Are Events Controlling You?

- 1. **Herod Agrippa an evil** Edomite ruler over Israel, <u>kills James</u> with the sword.
- 2. Herod likes the approval this gets him, so he seizes Peter and puts him in prison at Passover. (Unleavened Bread)
- 3. Death & Persecution (A victim mentality) are the world's focus.
- 4. Prayer & Passover are the Church's focus.
- 5. One focus is prison, the other is on the one who sets us free.

Acts 12:6-7

The Story Within the Story

- 1. Sinners are asleep.
- 2. Bound to their chains.
- 3. Guarded by Satan's demonic guards.
- 4. **Doomed** to die. He can do nothing.
- 5. So, God sends help from heaven and breaks the chains and sets us free!

Acts 12:8-12

Rescued

- 1. V:7 The "Get up" message from an angel.
- 2. V:8 Dress yourself to go.
- 3. V:10 See what doors or gates God opens and go through them.
- 4. When you've escaped, tell somebody you've been rescued!
- 5. Especially go tell the prayer meeting.

Acts 12:13-17

Testimonies Keep the Church Alive

- 1. V:13-14 Some won't believe it. Tell it anyway!
- 2. V:15-16 Some will think it's crazy. Tell it anyway.
- 3. V:17 Encourage others to tell your story.

Acts 12:18-24

Evil Authorities

- 1. Their day of being admired by others is short-lived.
- 2. V: 21-22 When evil receives praise that belongs to God, their judgement is sealed.
- 3. V:22-23 But the Word of God continues to flourish.

Acts 12:25

When your mission is complete, return home and share your testimony there.
