- 1. **In agreement** about prophecy? (1,878 years)
- 2. **Amillennial & Premillennial** do not view the scriptures in the same way. Why?
- 3. **Premillennial have lost credibility** because of the those that set dates for His return.
- 4. The Why Jesus is returning is more important than the when.

Acts 17:11 Now the Berean Jews were of more noble character than those in Thessalonica, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true.

# **Intimate Letters to the Bride**

- 1. **V: 1 Jesus sets** the protection of the churches through angels that are under His control. (Hebrews 1:14)
- 2. **He is in fellowship** (walks) with the Church.
- 3. **Seven Churches represent** the entire church age. Many connect the end of the church age with "the fullness of the Gentiles." (Romans 11:25)
- 4. **The letters** are from Jesus' heart to ours.
- 5. Each letter is personal message to a segment of the body of Christ, yet it applies to the whole.

### **Revelation 2:2-6**

# The Message

- 1. **V:2 You are persevering** and have not grown weary of being identified with His name.
- 2. V: 4 Forsaken love and a warning to consider how far you have fallen.
- 3. V:5 Repent or lose your place as a Church in my Kingdom.
- 4. V:5 Jesus himself will come and remove your place in the kingdom.

5. V:5 This could be saying? If they don't repent when Jesus comes, they don't join him in His Kingdom.

### **Nicolaitans**

- 1. **Hierarchy within the Church**. Those who rule over people and keep them from a personal relationship with Jesus. (This describes the Catholic Church & cults.)
- 2. **This practice and rule over people** will be embraced by the third Church with grave consequences.

### Revelation 2:8-11

# The Message

- 1. V:9 They are rich in spiritual riches.
- 2. V:10 They are persecuted for their faith with more persecution on the way.
- 3. V:10 Encouraged to not be afraid.
- 4. V:10-11 Be faithful even to the point of death. They will only die once.

## **Common Themes**

- 1. **Jesus declares** who He is to each church.
- 2. Rev. 2:1 The one who holds the church with authority. (right hand)
- 3. **Rev. 2:8** Who is the first and the last.
- 4. **Promises an outcome** to each church.
- 5. Rev. 2:7 The right to eat from the tree of life.
- 6. Rev. 2:11 Victor's crown & will not be hurt by the second death.
- 7. Rev. 2:7 & 11 The call to hear what the Spirit is saying to the Churches. Though Jesus speaks to each segment of the body separately, the message applies to the whole body.

# Parallel to the 7 Parables

- 1. Matthew 21:28– Matt. 25 Jesus gives 7 parables to His Church in his last week of life. See if you see a connection to these letters?
- 2. Matthew 21:28-32 The Two Sons. One gave lip service the other was obedient. (Fallen)
- 3. Matthew 21:33-44 The Vineyard & Tenants They are killed for working in vineyard.
- 4. The Church age, The first church is the <u>apostolic age</u>, the second church is the <u>persecuted age</u>. Again, each church represents a segment of the body yet is a part of the whole. (Revelation 2 & 3)
- 5. The Church age literally started on Pentecost Sunday with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. (Acts 2)
