

Revelation 14:1-5

Zion & The Outcome of the 144,000

- 1. **144,000** are Jewish witnesses 12,000 from each tribe of Judah. Where is Mount Zion? Hebrews 12:22
- 2. Rev. 13:7 Were they conquered and killed? V:4 They were a first fruit sacrifice.

Revelation 13:7 It (The Beast) was given power to wage war against <u>God's holy people</u> and **to conquer them.** And it was given authority over every tribe, people, language and nation.

- 3. **V:3** They have the privilege of the song of the redeemed is their song to sing in eternity.
- 4. V:4 Purity in a time of lawlessness is possible.
- 5. V:5 No lie was found in them. 2 Thess. 2:10 The great lie or deception will be upon the earth.

Revelation 14:6-7

The Eternal Gospel

- 1. V:6 God will use the 1st angel to get the message of the gospel out to a world that is under siege by the devil.
- 2. **V:7 Fear God** and give him glory because the hour of judgment has come. "Truth"
- 3. V:7 The eternal Gospel is about the Creator. (Read again) Romans 1:18-24

Revelation 14:8-10

The 2nd and the 3rd Angel

1. **The 2nd angel** gives the message about the falling of Babylon the Great. (Mystery)

- 2. The 3rd angel gives the warning at this mid-stage of the tribulation not to receive the mark of the beast.
- 3. **The connection between** the mark and tormented is made as the key to the warning.

Revelation 14:11-12

People in the Tribulation

- 1. V:11 Will people in the tribulation be offered eternity from the beast? Will they not experience the second death. Rev. 20:6
- 2. Rev. 13:9-10 & Rev. 14:12 God's People must: Be patient & faithful. (13:9) He who has an ear, let him hear.

Revelation 14:13-20

The Grape Harvest

- 1. **Jeremiah 25:30** "Now prophesy all these words against them and say to them: " 'The LORD will roar from on high; he will thunder from his holy dwelling and roar mightily against his land. He will shout like those who tread the grapes, shout against all who live on the earth.
- 2. **V:17-19 Jesus** and these two angels are doing battle against the wicked as Jesus returns to reign.
- 3. V:20 The blood in this battle is 4 feet deep up to the horses' bridles.

Isaiah 63:1-2 Who is this coming from Edom, from Bozrah, with his garments stained crimson? Who is this, robed in splendor, striding forward in the greatness of his strength? "It is I, proclaiming victory, mighty to save."

2 Why are your garments red, like those of one treading the winepress?

Isaiah 63:3-4 3 "I have trodden the winepress alone; from the nations no one was with me. I trampled them in my anger and trod them down in my wrath; their blood spattered my garments, and I stained all my clothing.

4 It was for me the day of vengeance; the year for me to redeem had come.
