Revelation 9:1-3a

The 5th Trumpet

- 1. A fallen star, he was given a key. Isaiah 14 & Ezekiel 28
- 2. Locust came out of the smoke & <u>were given power</u> to torture people without the seal of God.
- 3. Joel 2:4-5 Locust Like horses and a mighty army.

Revelation 9:3-4

The Seal of God

- 1. 2 Cor. 1:21-22 & 5:5 Sealed us with His Holy Spirit for <u>a purpose</u> that what is mortal would be swallowed up by life in Him.
- 2. Ephesians 4:30 Sealed by the Holy Spirit for <u>the day</u> of salvation.

Revelation 9:5-12

Like Locust (Demonic)...

- 1. Mark 5:12 "The Demonic"- Demons cannot inhabit without permission.
- 2. **V:1 & 5** "Given the key & not allowed"
- 3. V:10 They were given power to torment people for five months.
- 4. Genesis 7:22-24 Wrath, death, and water that covered the earth for 150 days.
- During Noah's 150 days of judgement of the world, death was everywhere. V:6 During the 5th trumpet death will elude those who sought it.
- 6. Question? How can death elude someone who wants to die?
- 7. V:11-12 The King in the world is the angel from the Abyss. The Destroyer.

Revelation 9:13-18

The One-Thirds

- 1. The first 4 Trumpets has a 1/3 mission, against the environment.
- 2. **The 6th trumpet** has a 1/3 mission against humanity by 4 angels who have been kept and bound to Euphrates.
- 3. Fire and Sulfur sounds like another judgment? Genesis 19:23-27

Revelation 9:19-20a

Parallel Plagues

- 1. Seven out the ten plagues in Egypt came <u>with</u> a warning. Exodus Chapters 7 thru 11
- 2. Water turns to blood. Rev. 8:8
- 3. Hail and fire. Rev. 8:7
- 4. Darkness Rev. 8:12
- 5. Locust Rev. 9:3

Trivia for future connection: What does **Revelation 9:21** have in common with the Exodus event of the 10 plagues?

Revelation 9:20b-21

Unrepented Hearts

- 1. Will continue to worship their gold, silver, idols and even demons.
- 2. **Will continue to be active in** looting, immorality, magical arts (Pharmaceuticals), and immorality.
